RECOGNITION OF SERVICE

This policy outlines the current criteria for recognition of service to the club, including Life Membership. It is based on the criteria brought into effect on October 16, 2010.

CRITERIA

To be considered for an award recognising service to the club, a person must be or have been:

- a member of Ulverstone Soccer Club as a committee member, administrator, coach, referee, volunteer or player; or
- a volunteer who offered their time around the club for duties including but not limited to canteen, gate, bar or coaching.

The person must also be:

- supportive of all club members at junior, youth and senior levels
- known for integrity, honesty and similar ethics

A person nominated for recognition must not have been involved in any activity or behaviour that is considered to have tarnished or diminished the reputation of the club at any time.

NOMINATION

In accordance with rule 8 of the association rules, nomination will be made to the committee in the form required at the time.

AWARDED

Recognition of Service Awards will be given for 10, 15 and 20 years of service and awarded as:

- 10 Years of Service
- Outstanding Service Award (15 years)
- Life Membership

Life Membership will only be awarded after 20 years of service to the club.

DECISION TO BESTOW AWARD

In accordance with rule 8.5 of the association rules, where, in the opinion of the committee and in consultation with current life members, a nominated person is determined to meet the above criteria, the committee will recommend the award be given at the next Annual General Meeting. Members attending the meeting will vote on bestowing the award.
