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COACH SELECTION

The following policy outlines the key criteria for selection coaches for all levels of Club Football at Ulverstone Soccer Club. The purpose of this document is to provide guidelines to assess the suitability of applicants for coaching positions within our club.

These criteria are deliberately broad to allow for the varied nature of experience and qualifications required depending on the level of coaching. Positions descriptions for specific coaching roles should be used in conjunction with this more general coach selection policy.

KEY ATTRIBUTES:

- Demonstrated ability to work as part of a team
- A passion for developing football players
- Effective communication skills
- Excellent organisational skills
- Proven ability to provide leadership and direction to players
- Desire to continuing developing personal coaching skills
- A good ambassador for the club
- Sets a positive example to players, parents and supporters regarding:
 - level of commitment
 - behaviour towards match officials and football participants
- Credibility with the local football community

QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE:

- Current Working with Vulnerable People card
- Coaching accreditation appropriate to the team being coached, or willing to undertake training
- Previous coaching experience applicable to the team being coached
- General understanding of the FFA National Curriculum and the role it plays
- Computer literacy is an advantage, but not essential

OTHER CRITERIA:

- Available to attend/facilitate training sessions for players at all levels
- Available to coach at applicable matches
- Willing to travel to games as required
- Willing to participate in club meetings, workshops, etc
- Willing to adhere to club policies and procedures
